

Notice of the 2026 Graduate Admissions Reexamination-School of New Media (English -Taught PhD Program)

1. Time and Form of the Reexamination

Reexamination form: online interview

Platform testing and qualification review: 10:00 a.m. (Beijing Time), January 16, 2026 (Friday).

Reexamination time: 9:00 am. (Beijing Time), January 20, 2026 (Tuesday)

Please read the "Appendix 1: Instructions for the Online Reexamination of the School of New Media" carefully for detailed information.

2. Submission of Reexamination Materials for International Students (Items 1-7 should be consistent with the materials submitted during the application):

- 1) Peking University 2026 Application Form for International Students for Enrollment, with complete signatures;
- 2) A copy of the valid identity document (international students submit a copy of the passport);
- 3) A copy of the degree certificate; fresh graduates in 2026 are required to provide proof of graduation in summer 2026;
- 4) Official transcripts from the graduating institution;
- 5) Personal statement (focusing on the research plan, approximately 3000 words for PhD program, template download URL:
<https://www.isd.pku.edu.cn/cn/down/brochures.php?cate=13>);
- 6) Proof of foreign language proficiency;
- 7) Thesis (fresh graduates can provide an abstract and content of the thesis, etc.); published academic papers and other original research achievements (if available);
- 8) "Integrity Reexamination Commitment". (Appendix 2)

The applicant must ensure the authenticity and accuracy of all the application materials submitted. Once it is found and verified that the information submitted by the applicant is not true or accurate, the applicant's reexamination qualification will be cancelled. If the applicant has already obtained the admission, it will be cancelled according to the "Procedures for Handling Violations in National Education Examinations".

All the application materials (items 1-8) should be mailed to the following address: Room 510, Mengminwei Building, Peking University, No.5 Yiheyuan Rd, Haidian District, Beijing 100871, PR China. phone number is 010-62766517. The application materials (do not bind) must be delivered no later than 4:00 pm on January 20, 2026 (for those who mail the materials from abroad, no later than January 28, 2026). Please use SF Express or China Post EMS to send the application materials. Those who fail to deliver on time will be deemed to have given up the reexamination qualification, and all application materials will not be returned once submitted.

3. Reexamination Arrangement:

Candidates who have obtained the reexamination qualification must participate in the platform test and conduct qualification review at the same time.

- 1) Review the graduation certificate and degree certificate for graduates of previous years; for those holding a foreign (overseas) degree certificate, the credential evaluation and recognition report issued by the Chinese Service Center for Scholarly Exchange (CSCSE) , Ministry of Education of China, must be provided.
- 2) For fresh graduates of 2026, review the original student ID card or proof of current enrollment with a complete registration seal.
- 3) Review the original proof of the foreign language proficiency of international students; it is necessary to log in to the registration website during the platform test to verify the results. Please prepare the username and password in advance for use.
- 4) Proof of identity: International students present the original passport.

The full score of the reexamination is 100 points, and 60 points are considered passing. Candidates scoring below 60 will not be admitted. The Institute of New Media does not accept transfers from other schools or majors.
